Bring your own picnic and let the children enjoy the bouncy castles, face painting, stalls and more. You will be able to buy ice cream, food, beverages and cakes, but the entertainment is free! The Leisure Centre has taster sessions for a small donation - no jeans or zips on clothing allowed - socks must be worn! The evening will culminate by the lighting of a beacon at 9.45pm - beacons will be lit at this time around the country.

You may have noticed that there is also a Queen's Platinum Jubilee Beacon Trail which has been running from 30 April and will continue until 12 June 2022 (see details below). I hope you all enjoy the trail with your children and that you join us in celebrating this once in a lifetime event in honour of her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II on Thursday 2 June. Parking will be available on the Health Centre car park and British Legion Club car park if there is room, but **NOT** at the rear of the Leisure Centre.

Unfortunately, there will be no hanging baskets this year, due to having to pay a charge to LCC to check that all the lamp posts are suitable for hanging baskets on! 

Has anyone seen one of these before?




