












CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

COPPULL NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN UPDATE



Just a reminder to all residents that when the Coppull Neighbourhood Plan becomes a statutory document, both the Parish Council and Chorley Borough Council, and indeed the Government, will have to consider its contents when planning applications are received for any building in Coppull.

There is still a lot of work to do, we are currently on version 9, and the Steering Group are doing their best

to proceed through the remaining 5 stages before the plan can be brought to the residents for a referendum for acceptance. Remember, we cannot stop building in Coppull, but the Neighbourhood Plan gives a recognised framework for what type of developments can happen and what considerations need to be made when planning these developments. We are working with a very experienced consultant who has brought over 200 Neighbourhood Plans into force and his guidance and understanding are beyond valuable.

We would welcome any offer of help from residents as there is still much work to be done, even if you feel you may not have any relevant experience or understanding, we still need people to do research and surveys to complete the plan. An hour or two will make a welcome contribution to the Steering Group, we'd love to have you on board!

LAMP LIGHT OF PEACE


COME AND JOIN US

SPEED AWARENESS

Is pushing your speed worth it?

You might have travelled the same route hundreds of times and think that driving slightly faster than the right speed for the conditions isn't risky, but even going a little too fast for the road conditions can increase your chances of being killed or seriously injured.

Remember, rural roads change quickly. Is pushing it worth it? THINK!

Speeding - the facts:

- When driving, a few miles per hour can mean the difference between life and death. The faster you drive, the less time you have to stop if something unexpected happens.
- pected happens.
 The speed limit is the absolute maximum and it doesn't mean it's safe to drive at this speed in all conditions.
- Speed contributes to around 1 in 4 fatal collisions on our roads, and on average kills and injures 58 young people a week. This includes collisions where the driver was within the speed limit but driving too fast for the road conditions.
- The minimum penalty for speeding is a £100 fine and 3 penalty points added to your licence. If you're still within 2 years of passing your driving test, your driving licence will be withdrawn if you build up 6 or more penalty points.

Rural roads - the facts:

- On average, three people die each day on country roads.
- In 2022, 61% of all young male car driver serious and fatal collisions happened on rural roads.

Please be aware of the above when driving through our village.

Most of our roads are 20mph!

WHAT 3 WORDS!

What3words is a proprietary geocode system designed to identify any location on the surface of Earth with a resolution of about 3 metres (9.8 ft). The what3words system and app is free for anyone to use.

Since 2019, What3words has seen adoption by emergency services, who can use it for free - businesses are charged. By September 2021, more than 85 percent of British emergency services teams used What3words. Download the app and find out your 3words, it could be useful in an emergency.
