

She took great delight in helping to make improvements around the village, together with her late husband Ken, and loved being Ken's consort when he was Mayor of Chorley. After Ken's death in 2016, Nora soldiered on and enjoyed her life with her family and friends. She met Frank and made the most of days out and holidays abroad, despite poor health. Nora will be very much missed.








# SAINT JOHN THE DIVINE

This article is about the beautiful War Memorial at Saint John the Divine Church, Coppull. The granite war memorial was dedicated in 1921 after the end of the First World War, one hundred years ago last year. It was unveiled by Brigadier General Darlington on 9 July 1921. The names of the fallen from the First World War were engraved on the memorial and the names of the fallen from World War Two were subsequently added. During the Remembrance Day service of November 2021, a visually impaired veteran who was laying a wreath stumbled over a concrete flag that had become loose.

Following on from this, a member of the public attending the service, John Chadwick, formed a small action commitee with John Harrison and Dave Whelan (John and Dave are both members of St. Johns PCC - Parochial Church Council).



They promptly moved the flag and took steps to make it safe again. Dave and John started to tidy up around the base by placing shuttering and laying white limestone chippings. John Chadwick, a local painter and decorator, cleaned the marble on the statue and repainted the names of all the fallen service men who are remembered on the war memorial. This was a very skilled and labour intensive task. Also, a local joiner, Greg Whelan, built some wooden crosses pictured here. These also act as flower planters.

Greg and John (pictured below with Dave Whelan) have also done other works around the Church on a voluntary basis. Dulux Paints, at no cost,



provided the unique paint that was required to repaint the names of the fallen servicement. Also, Alty's Builders Merchants of Chorley provided the material to make safe the approach to the war memorial. Stringfellows Builders of Coppull carried out the work to re-flag and tarmac the approach to the war memorial.



Each year there is a very poignant and moving service held in St. John's and, if you have ever attended, you will no doubt know what a wonderful service it is, and a very proud act of rememrance is also held at the war memorial.

Go along to Coppull Library to join in these digital sessions.


